GLORIA RAY KARLMARK

GLORIA RAY KARLMARK is one of the Little Rock Nine, a group of Black students who, in 1957, enrolled at the previously all-white Central High School in Little Rock, Arkansas, following the historical Supreme Court decision that declared segregation in public schools unconstitutional. This made them prominent figures in the history of the American Civil Rights movement, and they were awarded the Congressional Gold Medal for selfless heroism in 1999, and the Spingarn Medal in 1958.

SHE WAS BORN in 1942 as the third child to Harvey C Ray and Julia Miller. She graduated from Illinois Institute of Technology in 1965 and shortly after moved to Europe where she married Krister Karlmark. She has worked for IBM and Phillips and co-founded the journal Computers in Industry, for which she was editor-in-chief until 1991.

ELISABETH ÅSBRINK

ELISABETH ÅSBRINK, BORN 1965, is one of Sweden's most prominent non-fiction writers. She has written several praised books on historic and current topics, and has reached a widespread audience, especially with 1947. When Now Begins and And in the Vienna Woods the Trees Remain.

ÅSBRINK WAS NOMINATED for **The August Prize** for her first three books and won it for best nonfiction book 2011 for *And in Vienna the Trees Remain*. In addition to **The August Prize**, the book has been awarded the **Danish-Swedish Cultural Foundation Culture Award** in 2013, and **Rychard Kapuscinski Award** for best literary reportage in 2013.

GLORIA RAY WAS 14 years old when she was stopped by armed White soldiers from entering Little Rock Central High School in Arkansas. The year was 1957 and the governor of Arkansas refused to allow her and eight other Black teenagers to enter the all-white school. 'That day my childhood ended,' Gloria says today.


GLORIA RAY AND the others in the Little Rock Nine were the first to act on the 1954 Supreme Court decision that ruled the segregation of Black and White children in American schools unconstitutional. Arkansas' resistance to the decision was so strong and violent that President Dwight Eisenhower was forced to deploy elite armed troops to escort the nine Black children to school every day.

THE INCIDENT BECAME world news and a pawn in the Cold War, as well as a shocking exposure of racism in America. The Little Rock Nine are now icons in the history of the American civil rights movement.

BUT THE PRICE was high. They endured harassment, death threats and violence, and their parents and siblings suffered greatly, as did others who supported their fight for justice. In the end, the governor of Arkansas closed all public schools instead of allowing Black children to mix with White children, and thousands of young people were affected by the decision.

THIS IS THE story of that year that would change Gloria's life, but also of the American racism and slavery it grew out of, inextricably linked in the story of

the United States. Elisabeth Åsbrink writes with her eloquent narration, distinct voice, and unique ability to crack open key moments of conflict, oppression, and inequality by weaving together strands of personal and national history.



BERLIN BRÆNDER BERLIN IS BURNING

THE UNTOLD STORY OF THE DANISH CORRESPONDENTS WHO SURVIVED THE FALL OF THE THIRD REICH

DRAWING FROM PREVIOUSLY unpublished material, bestselling author Tom Buk-Swienty delves into a monumental documentary about a handful of Danish journalists in Berlin during World War II. While much of Europe fell to the Wehrmacht, Denmark was regarded by the Third Reich as a "Special Case." Although effectively occupied, Denmark remained officially neutral. Consequently, the Danish press was frequently and often forcefully encouraged to send their representatives to Berlin to cover the Reich's propaganda. This left these correspondents in a unique and Kafkaesque position, tasked with subtly reporting on both the rise and eventual fall of their oppressor.

IN THE MIDST of the political heat of the first war years, the narrative focuses on two central figures: Paul E. Stemann of Berlingske Tidende and Arild Hvidtfeldt of Socialdemokraten. Their firsthand accounts, previously unexplored by historians, provide a multifaceted and gripping portrayal of wartime Berlin. Stemann's unpublished memoirs, archived in the Imperial War Museum in London, and Hvidtfeldt's private collection offer unprecedented insights. Additionally, the book features private letters from Frederik Holck Colding, a young Danish diplomat who arrived in Berlin in 1944, and which were previously classified.

BEING AN INTERNATIONAL correspondent in war-time Berlin was not an easy situation to navigate while keeping your moral integrity. Every piece of correspondence and publication was meticulously scrutinised by the Sicherheitsapparat. As the war progressed, the propaganda machine became increasingly insistent on concealing German losses and the advances of the Allies, while also masking the atrocities committed both in mass graves abroad and on the streets of Berlin with colourful front-line reports and homefront articles. Stemann and Hvidtfeldt made great efforts to convey the truth between the lines to their readers at home, risking their lives in the process.

WHEN BERLIN SURRENDERED on May 2, 1945, the city lay devastated: 170,000 German and Russian soldiers had been killed, over 300,000 wounded and 100,000 civilians had perished. In the years leading up to the fall of the city, it was bombed to pieces and most of it lay in ruins when the war ended. Amidst this chaos, a group of Danish correspondents experienced the fall of the Third Reich first hand: Stationed in Hitler's capital during its darkest hours, they witnessed firsthand the relentless Allied bombings, the ruthless Russian invasion, and Berlin's final capitulation.

TOM BUK-SWIENTY masterfully weaves together this unique material into a compelling narrative, meticulously researched over years. *Berlin is Burning* marks the first volume in this gripping documentary, with *The Russians Are Coming* scheduled for release in spring 2025.
